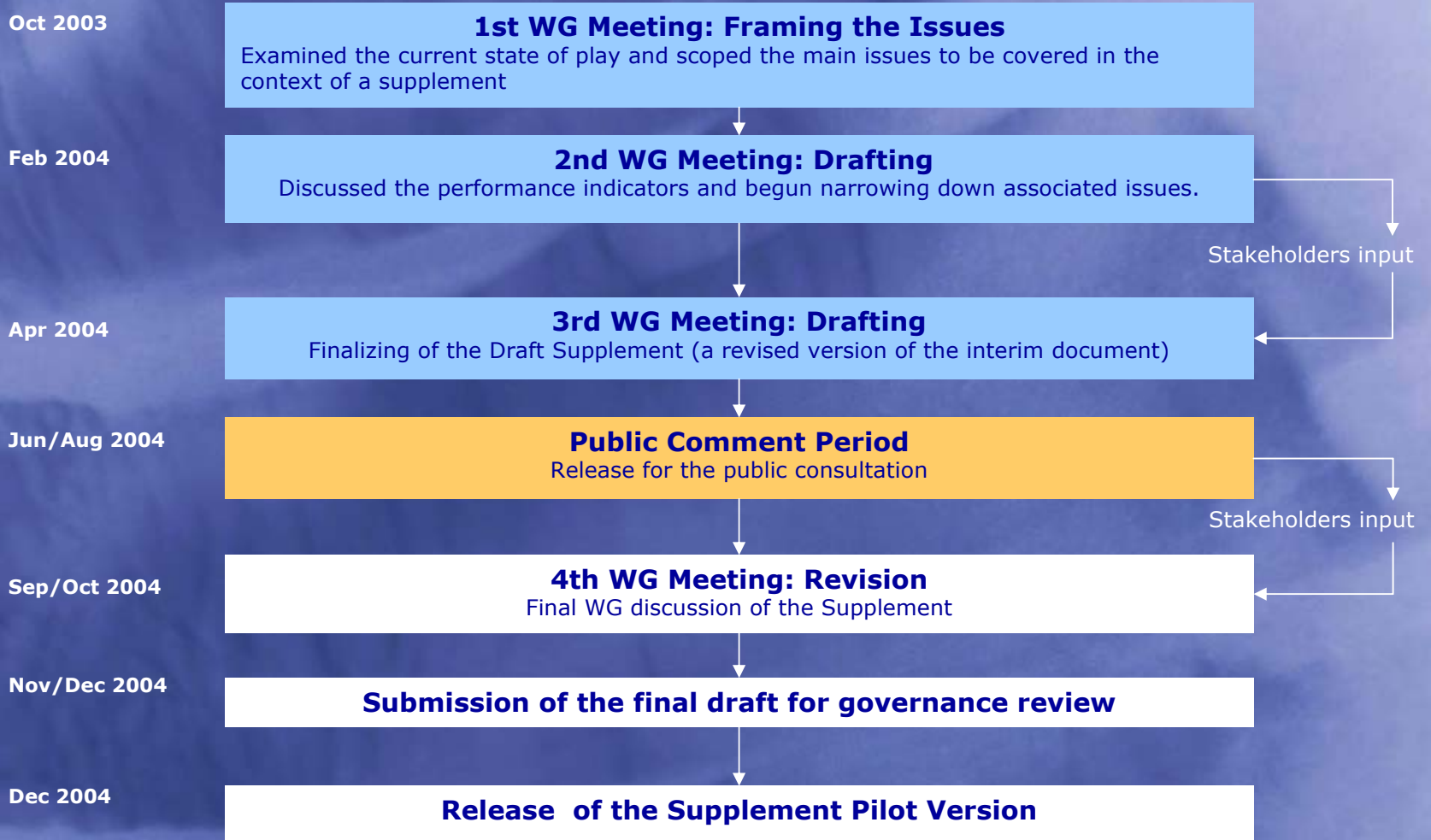

- **Part 1: Context section:** address sector-relevant issues which may not have specific performance indicators (e.g. stakeholder engagement)
- **Part 2: Sector-specific commentary** on existing GRI reporting elements and performance indicators
- **Part 3: New performance indicators**_specific to the sector covering **key aspects**
